Kornegay Design's new FencePost series of planters was inspired by the West's weathered cedar fence rails. The textured planters, designed by Phoenix artist Larry Kornegay, were shaped with molds formed with reclaimed cedar fencing that was sandblasted to reveal the wood's unique, rough texture. Made of high-strength concrete, the planters come in three sizes, multiple color options and were designed to serve as a natural-element contrast to the clean lines of contemporary architecture. "The FencePost series pushes what is nature and what is architecture," says Kornegay, whose firm was acquired by Landscape Forms last year. "The planters originated from wood."
